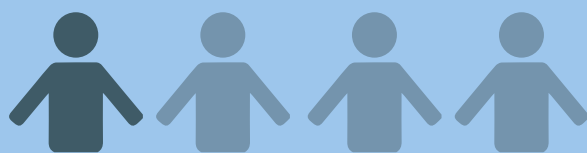

NO MATTER THE MODEL:



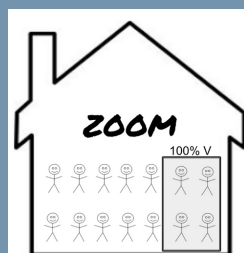
- The School Day - 6.5 hours
 - Morning (4 hours) = In-Person or Virtual
 - Afternoon (90-120 minutes) = Virtual
- Students will follow a daily schedule with class attendance
- Grading will occur in a traditional model.
- New content and learning daily - Same pace in-person or virtually.



HYBRID

Grades 6-12

- Students either are in-person or watching the lesson on Zoom while the lesson is occurring.
- New curriculum is delivered every day equally to virtual and in-person students.
- Students follow a typical daily schedule.
- 100% virtual students participate in their full schedule through Zoom.

High School Schedule:

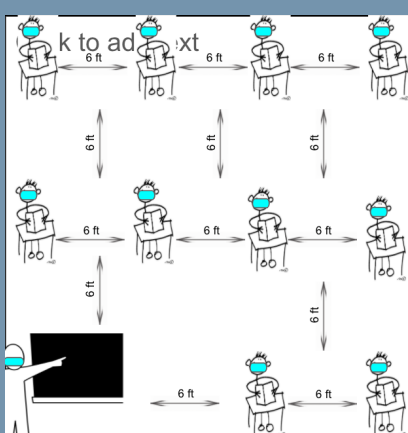
7:30-11:30 & 12:45-2:25

Grades K-5

- Students are in-person or on Zoom with a teacher. Hybrid students flip from in-person to virtual (2 teachers).
- New curriculum is delivered every day equally to virtual and in-person students daily.
- 100% virtual students participate in their full schedule through Zoom.

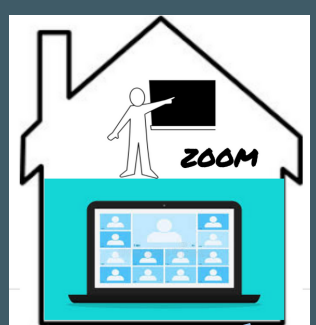

VIRTUAL

Grades 6-12



Virtual student "attends" live in-person classes via Zoom as they are happening at the school. The virtual student is 100% part of the class, just at home.

Grades K-5

Virtual student remains part of a class and a teacher team. Student works 100% of the time with a virtual teacher and whichever students are virtual on a given day.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS:

Possibly try to bring students in for some formal assessment or lab work

If schools need to CLOSE, the entire district would shift to 100% remote...Students would keep same schedule, just all learning is virtual!
